# BEPC FINANCIAL UPDATE

The chart above provides both the year-to-date (YTD) and month-of-December financial results for BEPC. With full year Income, Expenses and Surplus all in the black, 2011 was a very good year for BEPC financially. The primary drivers behind this were higher-than-budgeted rental income and expenses that were below budget due to no fulltime Minister until August. That said, we do have a Surplus of \$2,045. since Bruce started in August.

There will be a complete accounting of the 2011 financial results in the Annual Report.
